Means and standard deviations for the constructs.

The “**mean**” represents the average score from a scale of 1-4 that respondents answered on the survey. The higher the mean indicates agreement with each statement on average.

Standard deviation is a measure of how dispersed the data is in relation to the mean. Low standard deviation indicates data are clustered around the mean, and high standard deviation indicates data are more spread out.
