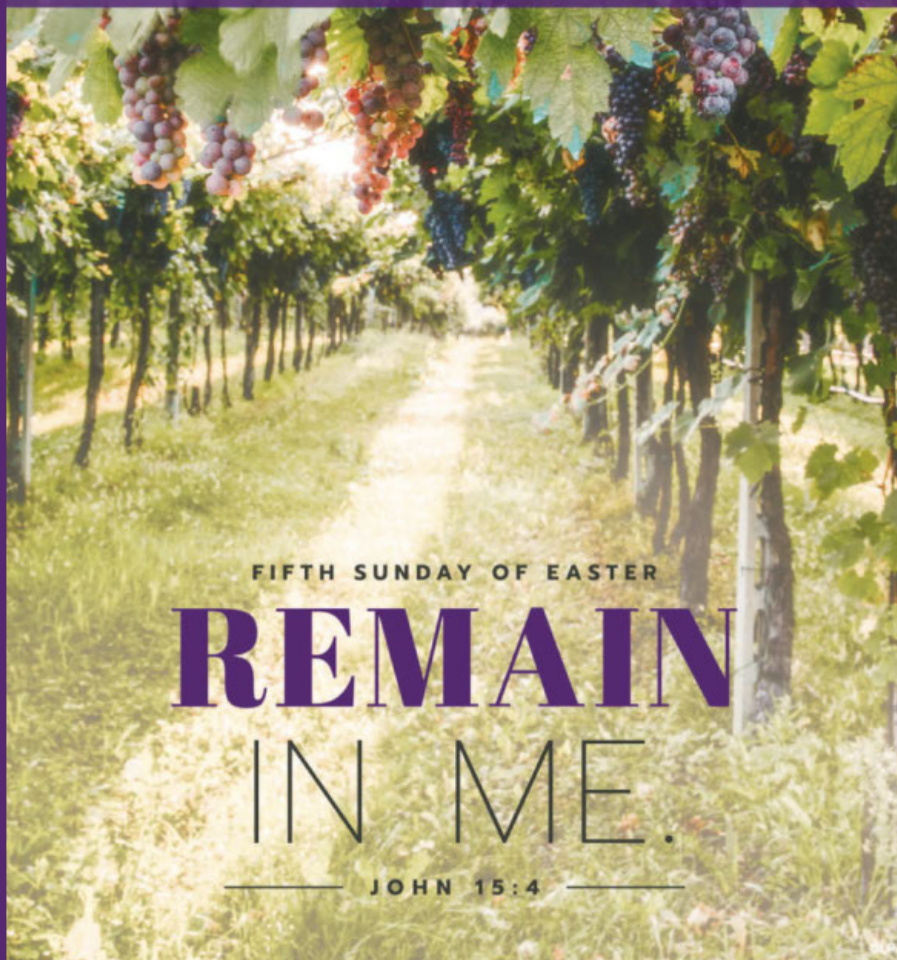

Are you ready for a trim?

In today's Gospel, we hear the familiar teaching of the vine and the branches. Jesus reminds us that if we remain close to him—living in humility, following God's law, loving our neighbor—we will notice a positive

change in our life and the lives of those around us. "Whoever remains in me and I in him will bear much fruit." The Holy Spirit is life-giving. He is fruitful. The Spirit of God won't refuse grace to a heart that is open.

As we progress through life, learning how to live and love, we grow. Our personalities flower. We discover what it is to be a blessing to others. We also experience lack, loss, and the results of our failures. We know what it is like to "wither" at times, particularly the times when we willingly separate ourselves from Jesus. "Just as a branch cannot bear fruit on its own unless it remains on the vine, so neither can you unless you remain in me." For most of us, this experience of being disconnected and off track generates a desire to return to what is right and good, to return to the vine.

But this Gospel is more than "Are you in or are you out?" Even when we remain in God, when we follow Jesus, we are not exempt from the challenge, the pruning. "Everyone that [bears fruit] he prunes." A prudent trim is necessary in the natural world of trees and vines. Dead wood, broken shoots, and diseased branches need to be cut back in order for the plant to bear fruit. Jesus wants us to be healthy! He says as much himself: "By this is my Father glorified, that you bear much fruit and become my disciples." Take a look at your life today. Where are you bearing fruit? Where do you need to be pruned?

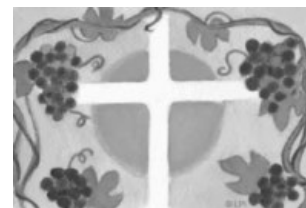

¿Estás listo para una poda?

En el Evangelio de hoy escuchamos la enseñanza de la vid y los sarmientos. Jesús nos recuerda que si permanecemos en Él (viviendo con humildad, siguiendo la ley de Dios, amando a nuestro prójimo) notaremos un cambio positivo en nuestra vida y en la de quienes nos rodean. *“El que permanece en mí y yo en él, dará mucho fruto”*. El Espíritu Santo es vivificante, es fructífero. El Espíritu Santo no nos negará la gracia cuando nuestro corazón está abierto.

A medida que avanzamos en la vida, aprendiendo a vivir y amar, crecemos. Nuestras personalidades florecen. Descubrimos lo que es ser una bendición para los demás. También experimentamos carencia, pérdida y los resultados de nuestros fracasos. Sabemos lo que es “marchitarse” a veces, particularmente cuando voluntariamente nos separamos de Jesús. *“Así como la vid no puede dar fruto por sí sola si no permanece en la vid, así tampoco nosotros si no permanecemos en Él”*. Para la mayoría de nosotros, esta experiencia de estar desconectados y fuera del camino nos genera un deseo de regresar a lo que es correcto y bueno, de regresar a la Vid.

Pero este Evangelio es más que “¿estás adentro o afuera?” Incluso cuando permanecemos en Dios, cuando seguimos a Jesús, no estamos exentos del desafío, de una buena poda. *“Todo el que da fruto lo poda”*. Una poda prudente es necesaria en el mundo natural de los árboles y las enredaderas. Es necesario cortar la madera muerta, los brotes rotos y las ramas enfermas para que la planta dé frutos. ¡Jesús quiere que estemos sanos! Él mismo lo dice: *“En esto es glorificado mi Padre: en que demos mucho fruto y sean mis discípulos”*. Echa un vistazo a tu vida hoy. ¿Dónde estás dando frutos? ¿Dónde necesitas que te poden?

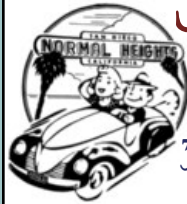
