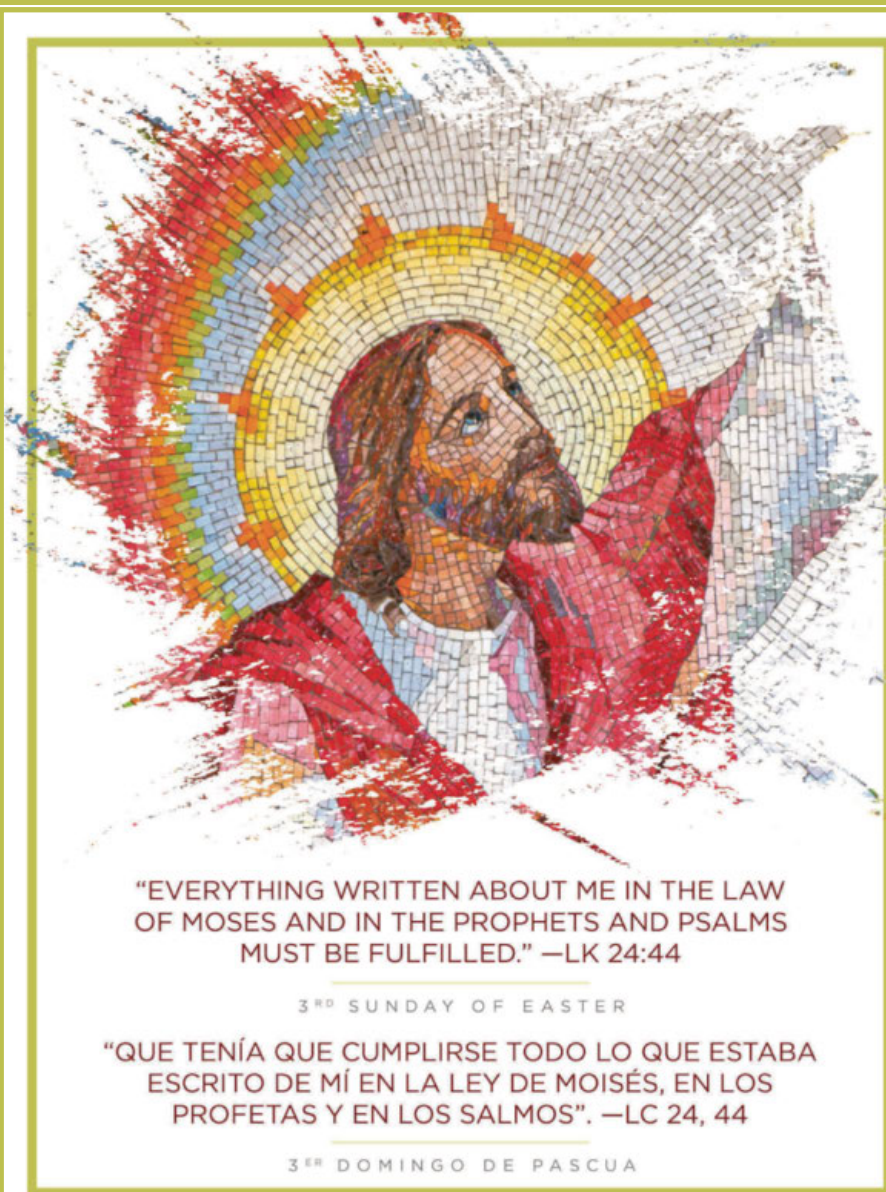

“Why do questions arise in your hearts?”

After the Resurrection, the Apostles experienced their fair share of incredulity. Jesus had died—John had been there—and now the tomb was empty. What should they believe? Was the

Jesus before them truly real? And who was Jesus really? It’s no surprise that the Apostles were initially “startled and terrified” to the extent that they “thought that they were seeing a ghost.”

Jesus has compassion on his confused friends. Once he affirms his non-ghostly identity—“look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself”—Jesus gets down to business. He has risen from the dead, but life would not continue as normal. Throughout Jesus’ ministry, he spoke in parables and veiled prophetic language. His followers likely thought much of his words were metaphors, some symbolism for the person and their relation to God. Now Jesus has something else in mind. He “opened their minds to understand the scriptures,” making known the connections between his own words and deeds and “everything written about him in the law of Moses and in the prophets and psalms.”

Why now? Why this increased depth of understanding? The answer lies in the shifting role of the Apostles. “You are witnesses of these things.” The treasury of truth is no longer Jesus’ responsibility alone but our own. Then and there, the Apostles are appointed to proclaim the death and resurrection of Jesus, the forgiveness of sins and the mercy of God. This message is no longer for only the Jewish people but “all the nations.”

This is our invitation! We have the rich heritage of the Church’s teaching. By sacramental grace, God’s “peace” is “with us.” We, too, are sent to proclaim the Good News of Jesus Christ and the hope that belongs to his call. —Cycles of Faith

Treasures from the Holy Land Sale Next weekend after all the Masses

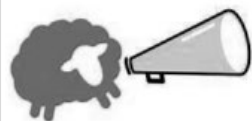

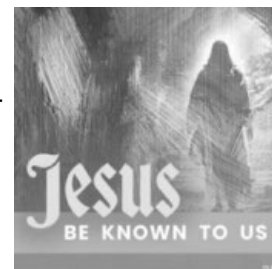

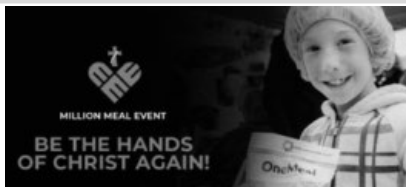

“¿Por qué surgen preguntas en nuestros corazones?”

Después de la Resurrección, los apóstoles experimentaron una buena dosis de incredulidad. Jesús había muerto (Juan había estado allí) y ahora la tumba estaba vacía.

¿Qué deberían creer? ¿Era realmente real el Jesús que tenían ante ellos? ¿Y quién era Jesús realmente? No sorprende que los Apóstoles inicialmente estuvieran “sobresaltados y aterrorizados” hasta el punto de que “creyeron que estaban viendo un fantasma”.

Jesús tiene compasión de sus amigos confundidos. Una vez que afirma su identidad no fantasmal (“mira mis manos y mis pies, que soy yo mismo”), Jesús se pone manos a la obra. Ha resucitado de entre los muertos, pero la vida no continuaría normalmente. A lo largo de su ministerio, Jesús habló en parábolas y en un lenguaje profético velado. Sus seguidores probablemente pensaron que muchas de sus palabras eran metáforas, algún simbolismo de la persona y su relación con Dios. Ahora Jesús tiene algo más en mente. Él “les abrió la mente para entender las Escrituras”, dando a conocer las conexiones entre sus propias palabras y hechos y “todo lo escrito acerca de él en la ley de Moisés, en los profetas y los salmos”.

¿Por qué ahora? ¿A qué se debe esta mayor profundidad de comprensión? La respuesta está en el papel cambiante de los apóstoles. “Ustedes son testigos de estas cosas”. El tesoro de la verdad ya no es responsabilidad exclusiva de Jesús sino nuestra. En ese mismo momento, los apóstoles son designados para proclamar la muerte y resurrección de Jesús, el perdón de los pecados y la misericordia de Dios. Este mensaje ya no es sólo para el pueblo judío sino para “todas las naciones”.

¡Esta es nuestra invitación! Tenemos la rica herencia de las enseñanzas de la Iglesia. Por gracia sacramental, la "paz" de Dios está "con nosotros". Nosotros también somos enviados a proclamar la Buena Nueva de Jesucristo y la esperanza que corresponde a su llamado.

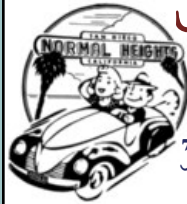
