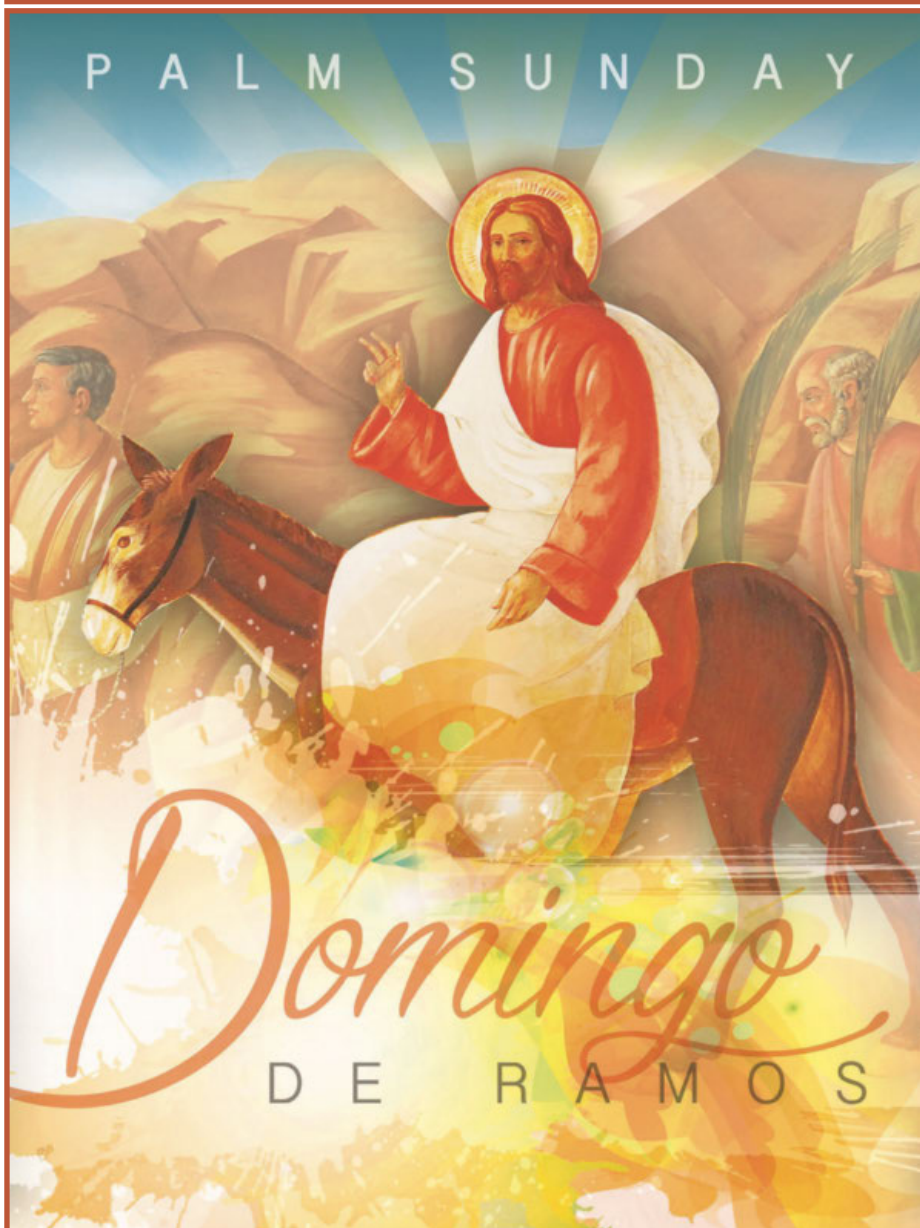

### Following Without Reserve

Woven into the narrative of Christ's passion, Luke details a variety of responses and reactions from those who came into contact with Jesus on his way to the cross. Jesus, of course, is aware of the dramatic way his life will come to an end, but for the others, Jesus's arrest, trial, public torture, and execution will be an unbelievably sorrowful experience that is unlike anything they can imagine. Even Jesus's closest disciples have no concept of the strength and the depth of love that will be required of them in the days ahead.

Peter's friendship with Jesus is perhaps one of the most tender, detailed, and directive trajectories in Scripture. At the Last Supper, Peter cannot stomach the prophecy of his betrayal and desperately expresses his desire to be at Jesus's side, risking prison or death over denial. It's not as if Peter lies to Jesus about his desire; he simply does not comprehend the cost of his fidelity. Even so, Jesus accepts Peter's claims, even while still foretelling the denial, but also predicts the grace that Peter will provide his brothers—indeed the entire church—once he turns back. Despite Peter's best attempt, it is not enough. But Jesus accepts what Peter can give.

Of course, it's not just Peter who will abandon Jesus. The same voices in the crowds who acclaimed Jesus with hosannas will inevitably shout for the release of Barabbas (whose name means "son of the father").

Each of us desires to respond to Jesus with profound fidelity and bravery, unafraid to be known as his friend and follower. Yet in that process of wrongly choosing something or someone who is not Christ, we learn our frailty. Humanity cannot adequately respond to God who is love itself. But the Lord accepts our efforts. Through it all, we are confronted with the reality that we need a Redeemer, and we clearly recognize the gift that the Lord wants to give us.

If he truly is the Son of God, we must follow him without reserve. Only when he gives us his Spirit will we be able to do so.

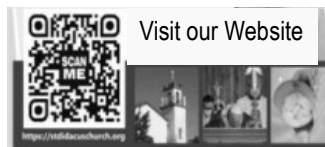

### Siguiendo Sin Reservas

Entrelazado con la narración de la pasión de Cristo, Lucas detalla diversas respuestas y reacciones de quienes entraron en contacto con Jesús camino a la cruz. Jesús, por supuesto, es consciente del dramático final de su vida, pero para los demás, el arresto, el juicio, la tortura pública y la ejecución de Jesús serán una experiencia increíblemente dolorosa, diferente a todo lo que puedan imaginar. Incluso los discípulos más cercanos de Jesús desconocen la fuerza y la profundidad del amor que se les exigirá en los días venideros.

La amistad de Pedro con Jesús es quizás una de las trayectorias más tiernas, detalladas y directas de las Escrituras. En la Última Cena, Pedro no puede digerir la profecía de su traición y expresa desesperadamente su deseo de estar al lado de Jesús, arriesgándose a la cárcel o la muerte por negarlo. No es que Pedro le mienta a Jesús sobre su deseo; simplemente no comprende el precio de su fidelidad. Aun así, Jesús acepta las afirmaciones de Pedro, aunque todavía predice la negación, pero también predice la gracia que Pedro brindará a sus hermanos —de hecho, a toda la iglesia— una vez que regrese. A pesar de los mejores esfuerzos de Pedro, no es suficiente. Pero Jesús acepta lo que Pedro puede dar.

Por supuesto, no es solo Pedro quien abandonará a Jesús. Las mismas voces de la multitud que aclamaron a Jesús con hosannas inevitablemente gritarán pidiendo la liberación de Barrabás (cuyo nombre significa "hijo del padre").

Cada uno de nosotros desea responder a Jesús con profunda fidelidad y valentía, sin temor a ser conocido como su amigo y seguidor. Sin embargo, en ese proceso de elegir erróneamente algo o a alguien que no es Cristo, descubrimos nuestra fragilidad. La humanidad no puede responder adecuadamente a Dios, que es el amor mismo. Pero el Señor acepta nuestros esfuerzos. A través de todo esto, nos enfrentamos a la realidad de que necesitamos un Redentor y reconocemos claramente el don que el Señor quiere darnos.

Si realmente es el Hijo de Dios, debemos seguirlo sin reservas. Solo cuando nos dé su Espíritu podremos hacerlo. —*Liturgia Viva 2025*

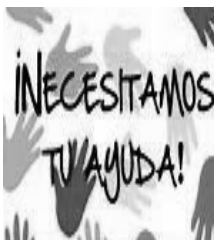

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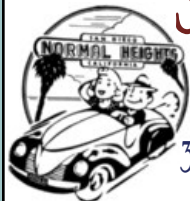
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
