God Seeks Us Out

In the beginning, when God creates the heavens and the earth, he forms Adam and Eve in his image. They are sinless, and are given everything they

could possibly want or need. Not soon after, their relationship with God is broken by the sin of pride, and they choose to believe the lie that God is not trustworthy. Now, in their shame, they recognize their nakedness, and they are embarrassed. They take yet another step away from God and hide themselves among the trees as God walks through the garden.

Despite their sin and their choice to run from God's love, we see that it is the Father who comes to his children. In response to their sin, God walks among them, calls them by name, and desires to be near them. The Lord is one who works to repair the relationship.

Despite our sinfulness and the choices we make to run away from the Father's love, Christ, the new Adam, comes into the world. He crosses the distance and becomes one of us in order to be close to us. Through his life, death, and resurrection, we learn the true nature of God's love. It is Jesus who has taken the first step, and now, with the gift of the Spirit, we can move toward Jesus and become like him.

God does not abandon his people. In sin, in darkness, in misfortune, in vulnerability, in fear, he comes to them and he seeks them out. Whether his children, hide themselves in the garden or lock themselves in an upper room, he comes to them and he seeks them out. Our woundedness is the very place where God meets us. Jesus's resurrection does not erase the wounds in his flesh; instead, the wounds are glorified. Now all suffering, pain, and shame is transformed. We do not need to be ashamed of our nakedness, Christ clothes us in a robe of eternal glory. We do not need to fear our wounds; they are glorified in Christ.

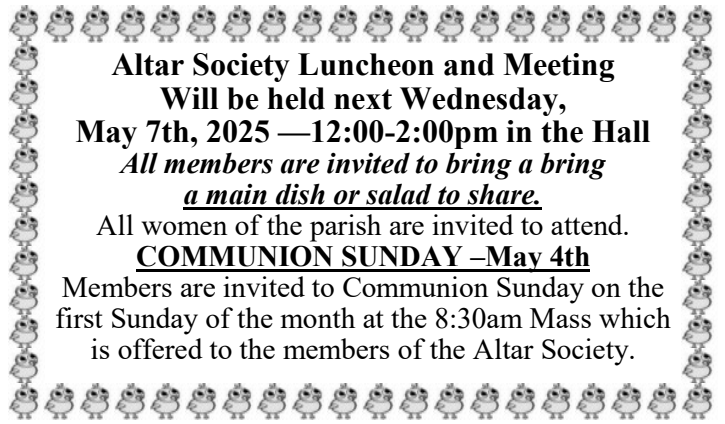

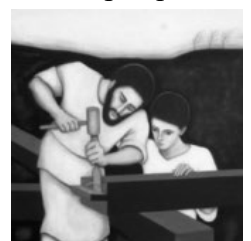

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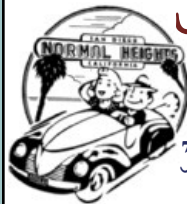
