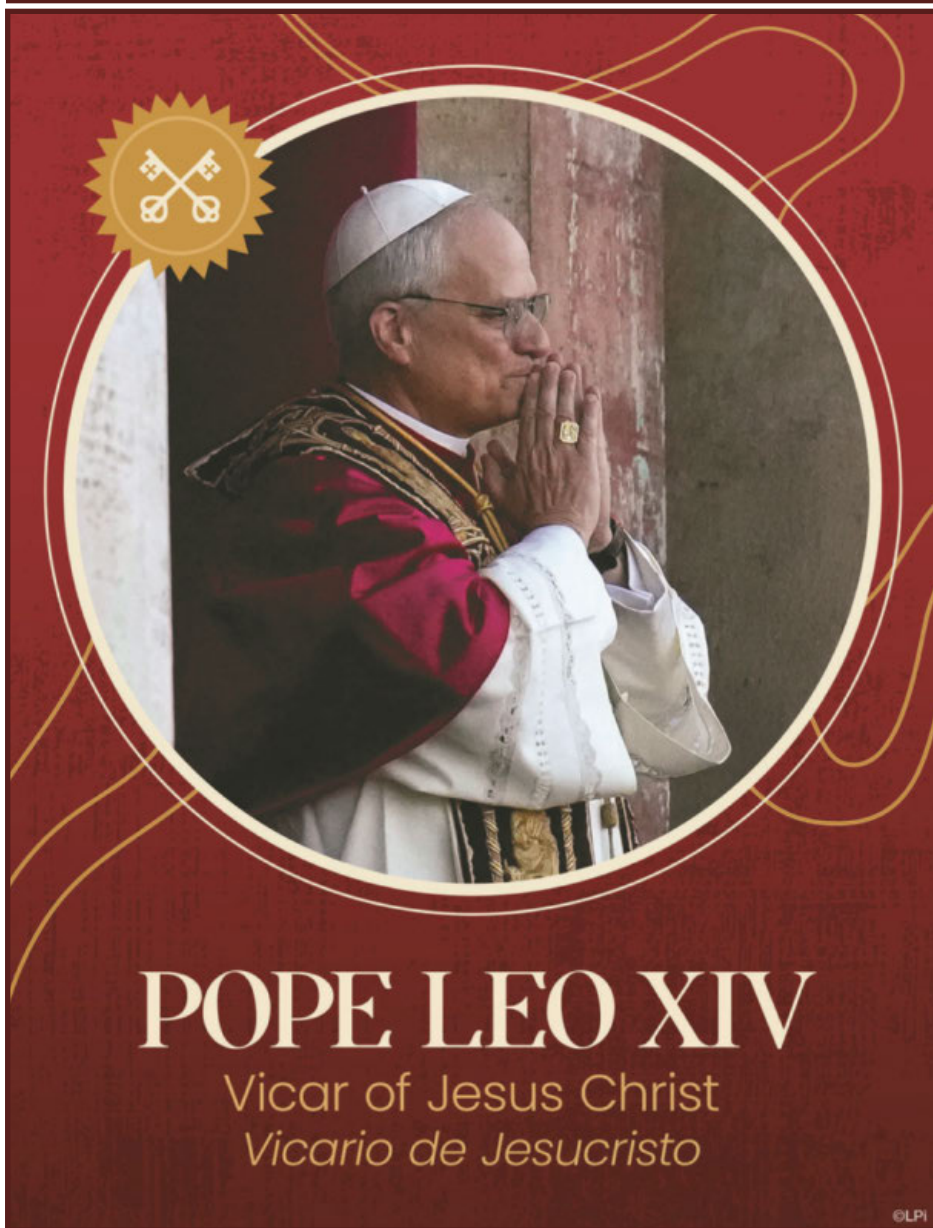

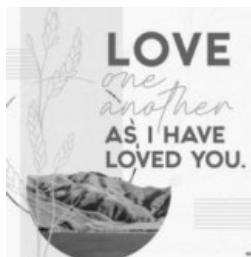

Love Until It Hurts

Certainly, the disciples knew of the command to love one another, but Jesus expands the command by requiring his disciples to love as he loves.

The *Roman Missal's* Preface III of Easter reminds us that one particular way the "Christ our Passover" expresses his love in the way that he "defends us and ever pleads our cause before" the Father. The Lord is able to be an advocate for us because he understands our poverty and our pain. In his radical self-emptying, he becomes one of us and experiences our humanity in his own flesh. Knowing precedes loving. One cannot love someone he does not know. Jesus goes to incredible lengths to know us, even to the point of *becoming* one of us.

For the disciples of Jesus, loving one another will now mean imitating the sacrifice of Christ in their daily lives and seeing in each other the face of God. It will mean defending and advocating for the poorest of the poor, perhaps even those whose interests may not be of interest to them. It will mean that the stranger becomes a friend, that service becomes accompaniment. It will mean knowing the poor and feeling their pain.

Living out this commandant requires some level of solidarity with those we are called to love. When we share in the successes, hopes, and desires of the poor and feel their pain, we will find that we are drawn even more deeply into the mystery of Christ's love. Saint Teresa of Calcutta once said, "I have found the paradox that if you love until it hurts, there can be no more hurt, only more love. —*Living Liturgy 2025*

U.S. Cardinal Elected Pope

"Peace be with you," were Pope Leo's first words to the multitudes at St. Peter's Basilica.

The Administrator of the Diocese of San Diego, Bishop Michael Pham, issued the following statement today after Cardinal Robert F. Prevost was elected the new pope of the Catholic Church:

It is with great joy we greet the news that the world has a new Pope! Pope Leo XIV, an American from Chicago and an Augustinian!

Pope Leo XIV has split his priestly life between his beloved Chicago, assignments in Rome and serving as a missionary and later a diocesan bishop in Peru. He was made a cardinal by Pope Francis in 2024 and headed the Dicastery for Bishops, a position in the Vatican that advises the Pope on the selection of bishops around the world.

We ask that all the People of God in the Diocese of San Diego pray for Pope Leo, to give him the wisdom, the strength and all the other gifts needed to guide our Church in these challenging times.

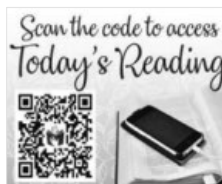

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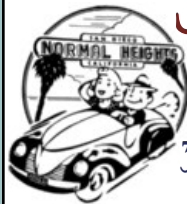
