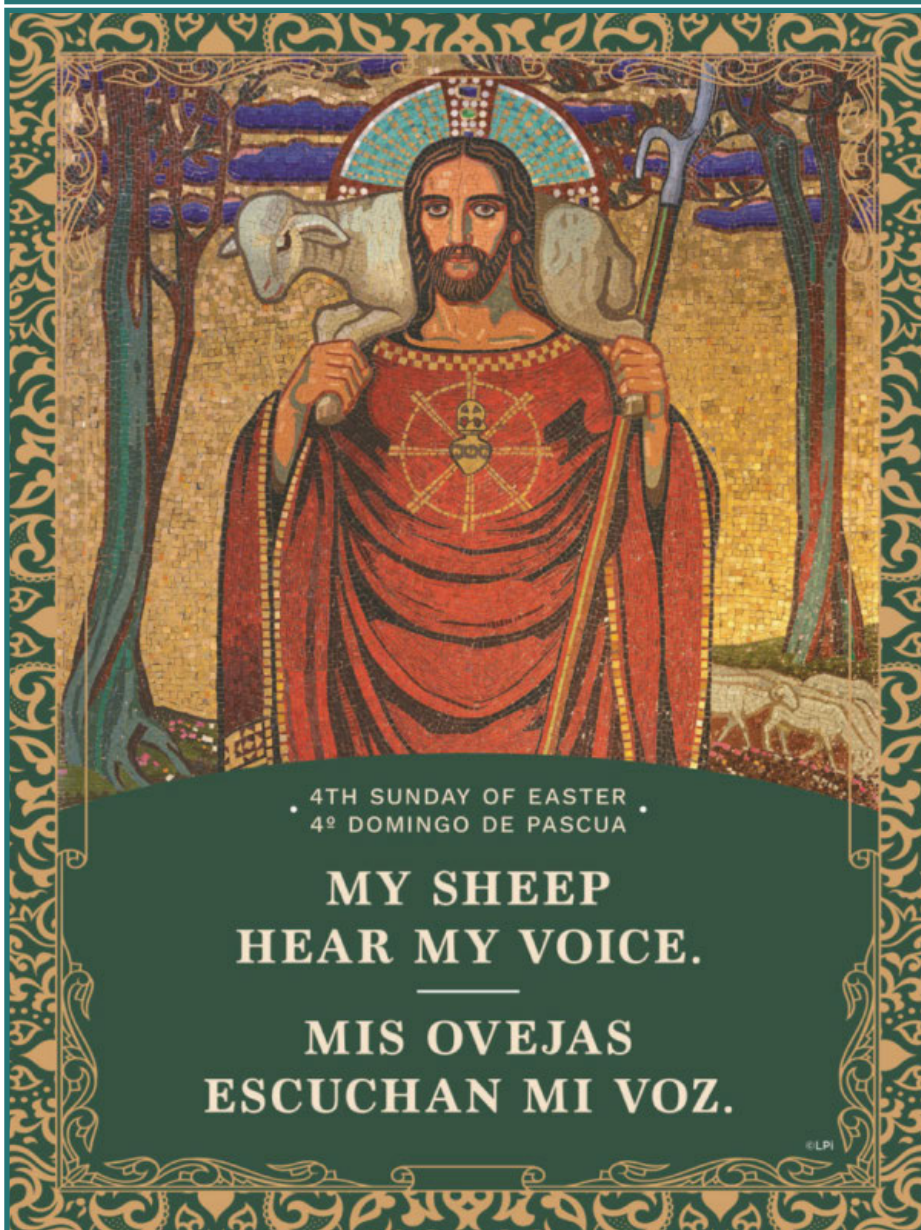

I Know Them

Shepherding is still a way of life for many around the world, and there is a special relationship between the sheep and their shepherd. The sheep trust the shepherd. They know and follow his unique voice as they are led to green pastures and away from danger.

But read carefully the first line in this gospel passage from John. Notice that it is not the sheep that know the shepherd but the *Shepherd* who knows his sheep: "The sheep hear my voice. I know them, and they follow me."

We are God's people, the sheep of his flock, and the voice that we hear belongs to the One who knows us and created us. It is with him whom we follow.

Psalm 139 reminds us that our loving God knows everything about us. We are created with thoughtfulness and intentionality. The Lord knows our desires, our thoughts, what we have done, and what we will do. We cannot do more to earn his love, nor can we do anything to be disqualified from receiving it. "No one can take them out of my hand."

To belong to the Good Shepherd means that we desire to follow his voice, a voice that promises us eternal rest. Of course, we are hardwired to know and desire the Lord. As St. Augustine said, our hearts are restless until they rest in God. So even our deepest yearnings are a summons from the Good Shepherd, to draw us closer to himself. Our prayers are but a response to the Lord, who is constantly initiating this dialogue of love within us.

The Shepherd can ultimately say that he knows us because he became one of us. He knows our needs, our desires, our emptiness, and even our death. But the Lamb once slain dies no more. We belong to him, his indelible mark cannot ever be erased or taken away.

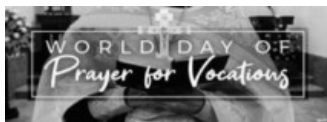

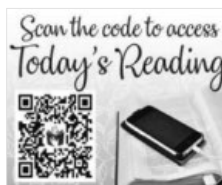

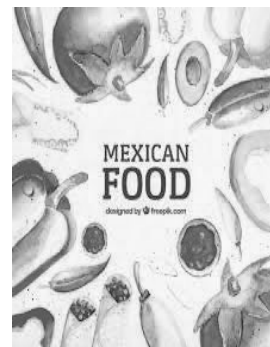

Pastorear sigue siendo una forma de vida para muchos en todo el mundo, y existe una relación especial entre las ovejas y su pastor. Las ovejas confían en el pastor.

Conocen y siguen su voz única mientras son guiadas a verdes pastos y alejadas del peligro. Pero lean con atención la primera línea de este pasaje del Evangelio de Juan. Observen que no son las ovejas las que conocen al pastor, sino el Pastor quien conoce a sus ovejas: «Las ovejas oyen mi voz. Yo las conozco y me siguen».

Somos el pueblo de Dios, las ovejas de su rebaño, y la voz que escuchamos pertenece a Aquel que nos conoce y nos creó. Es a Él a quien seguimos.

El Salmo 139 nos recuerda que nuestro Dios amoroso lo sabe todo sobre nosotros. Fuimos creados con consideración e intencionalidad. El Señor conoce nuestros deseos, nuestros pensamientos, lo que hemos hecho y lo que haremos. No podemos hacer más para merecer su amor, ni podemos hacer nada para quedar descalificados para recibirlo. «Nadie puede arrebátarmelos de mi mano».

Pertenecer al Buen Pastor significa desear seguir su voz, una voz que nos promete el descanso eterno. Por supuesto, estamos programados para conocer y desear al Señor. Como dijo San Agustín, nuestro corazón está inquieto hasta que descansa en Dios. Así, incluso nuestros anhelos más profundos son una llamada del Buen Pastor para acercarnos a él. Nuestras oraciones no son más que una respuesta al Señor, quien constantemente inicia este diálogo de amor dentro de nosotros.

El Pastor puede decir, en última instancia, que nos conoce porque se hizo uno de nosotros. Conoce nuestras necesidades, nuestros deseos, nuestro vacío e incluso nuestra muerte. 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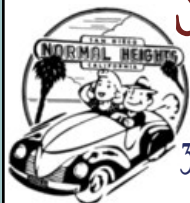
