Go Forth in Love to Serve Him

In times of uncertainty, friends get together and regroup; they meet in places that offer familiarity and comfort. So it was that the disciples gathered at the sea, to go fishing, following the Resurrection.

They were probably still reeling from all that happened: Jesus' suffering and death, his empty tomb, his appearances to them as they hid in fear. The risen Lord has given them his peace and breathed his Spirit upon them. Although perhaps they still do not understand the full significance of these events, they believe Jesus lives and they have come out of hiding. What to do now? They ponder; they talk; they work together to catch fish; they wait.

It is to this eager but still hesitant and mission-less group of disciples that Jesus appears, once more. This encounter will empower and encourage them, and clarify further their calling, their roles, and their mission. Once again Jesus feeds them, and once again he teaches them. Once again, Peter is the focus of Jesus' lesson.

More than anyone perhaps, Peter needs to be reminded how Jesus cared for him, loved him, and led him, and will continue to do so. When Jesus appears at the sea and helps them catch a net full of fish, it is just like the first time Peter met Jesus. The memories of that powerful experience must have come flooding back. He would remember Jesus telling him: *Do not be afraid, from now on you will be catching men* (Lk 5:10).

Jesus asks Peter three times: "Do you love me?" Unlike the three times Peter denied Jesus, Peter is now able to affirm him in his answers. Jesus instructs him to care for his lambs and to follow him, even to places *where you do not want to go*. Peter needed this time of remembrance in order to move forward and be ready for what would come. He needed the reminder of Jesus' love and care, in order to continue to follow him.

As we come together for the Eucharist, we, like the disciples, are reminded of Jesus' love for us. He offered himself for us on the cross, and now he nourishes us with the spiritual strength to follow him. We must remember that we are loved if we are going to go out and love God and others. Then we can go forth in love to serve him, as he calls all of his disciples to do.

**Salgan con Amor a Servir**

En tiempos de incertidumbre, los amigos se reúnen y se reagrupan; se reúnen en lugares que ofrecen familiaridad y consuelo. Así fue como los discípulos se reunieron junto al mar para pescar después de la Resurrección.



Probablemente aún estaban conmocionados por todo lo sucedido: el sufrimiento y la muerte de Jesús, su tumba vacía, sus apariciones mientras se escondían con miedo. El Señor resucitado les ha dado su paz y les ha infundido su Espíritu. Aunque quizás aún no comprenden el significado completo de estos acontecimientos, creen que Jesús vive y han salido de su escondite. ¿Qué hacer ahora? Reflexionan; hablan; trabajan juntos para pescar; esperan.

Es a este grupo de discípulos ansiosos, pero aún indecisos y sin misión, a quien Jesús se le aparece una vez más. Este encuentro los empoderará y animará, y les aclarará aún más su llamado, sus roles y su misión. Una vez más, Jesús los alimenta y una vez más les enseña. Una vez más, Pedro es el centro de la lección de Jesús. Quizás más que nadie, Pedro necesita que le recuerden cómo Jesús lo cuidó, lo amó y lo guio, y seguirá haciéndolo. Cuando Jesús aparece en el mar y les ayuda a pescar una red llena de peces, es como la primera vez que Pedro conoció a Jesús. Los recuerdos de esa poderosa experiencia debieron de inundarlo. Recordaría que Jesús le dijo: «No temas, desde ahora serás pescador de hombres» (Lc 5,10).

Jesús le pregunta a Pedro tres veces: «¿Me amas?». A diferencia de las tres veces que Pedro negó a Jesús, ahora puede afirmarlo en sus respuestas. Jesús le instruye a cuidar de sus ovejas y a seguirlo, incluso a lugares donde no quiere ir. Pedro necesitaba este momento de recuerdo para seguir adelante y estar preparado para lo que vendría. Necesitaba el recordatorio del amor y el cuidado de Jesús para seguir siguiéndolo.

Al reunirnos para la Eucaristía, nosotros, como los discípulos, recordamos el amor de Jesús por nosotros. Se ofreció por nosotros en la cruz, y ahora nos nutre con la fuerza espiritual para seguirlo. Debemos recordar que somos amados si queremos salir a amar a Dios y al prójimo. Entonces podremos salir con amor a servirle, como él llama a todos sus discípulos a hacerlo. —Faith Catholic 2025

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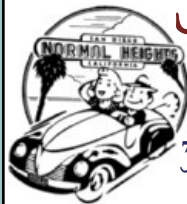
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
