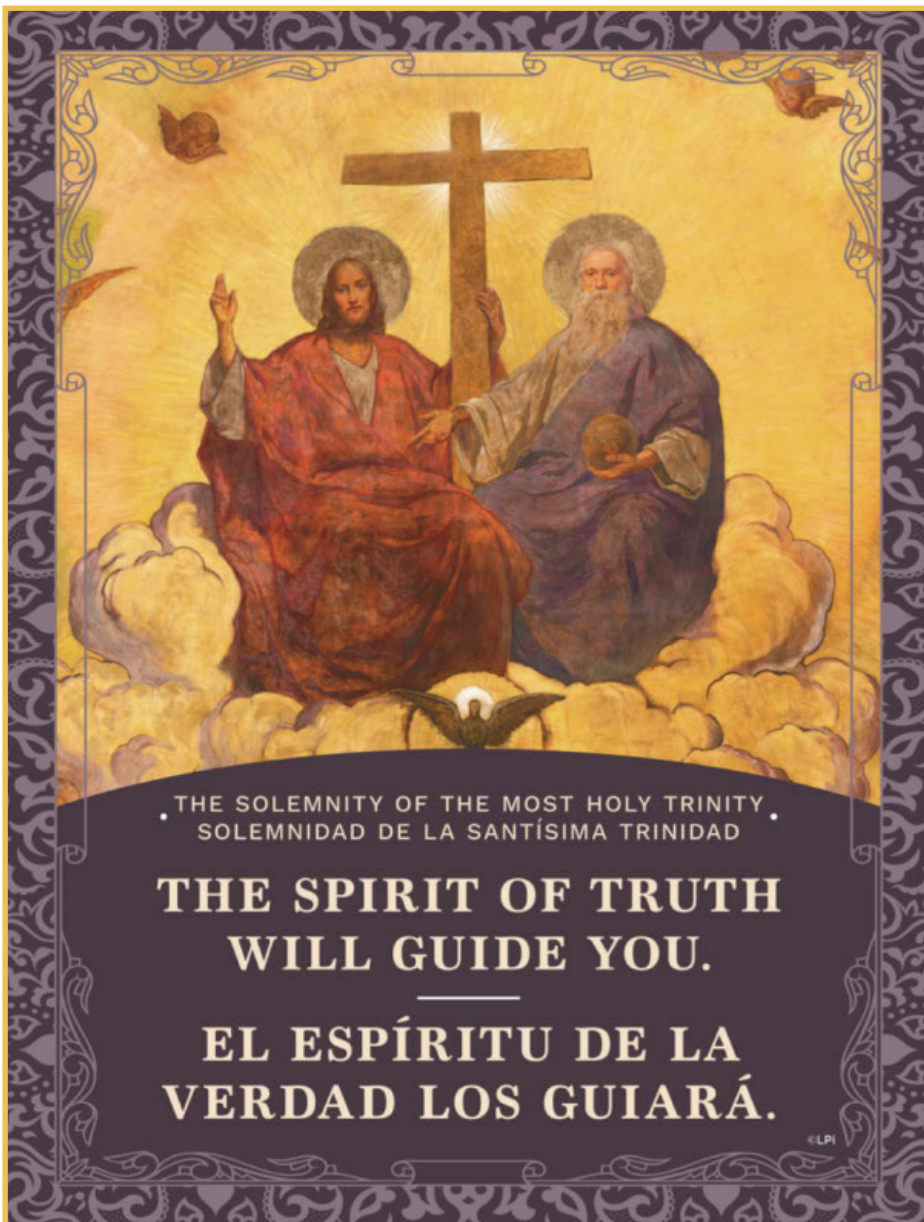

The Sign of the Cross

We frequently bless ourselves with the sign of the cross, but oftentimes it is easy to forget the significance of this blessing and the incredible grace that it offers.

The prayer invokes the trinitarian God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We sign ourselves with the cross of Christ, and, invoking the Trinity, we demonstrate a desire to consecrate ourselves and our work to the Lord. This external sign also tells others that we belong to God and believe in the power of the cross. It tells others that we are affected by Christ's gift of love.

The sign of the cross is, in fact, a blessing. It recalls our baptism when we were first signed with the cross and claimed for Christ. It was also at our baptism that we first received the Spirit of Adoption.

By marking our bodies with the cross, we remember Jesus's passion and proclaim the power of his death. It is an acknowledgement of our belief that Jesus is Lord and that his cross brings with it the hope or resurrection.

The sign of the cross is done with our right hand, recalling that Jesus Christ sits as King at the right hand of the Father. We might even join our thumb and first two fingers together during the blessing to further embody the three-in-one nature of the God we invoke.

The use of this gesture is not limited to the beginning and ending of prayers. It is a blessing that ought to be used frequently as we ask for God's protection, wisdom, courage, insight, and peace. We might even use it to acknowledge God's presence with us.

The sign of the cross is a concrete sign of God's love and the ongoing action of the Trinity in our daily lives.

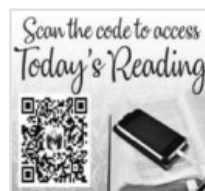

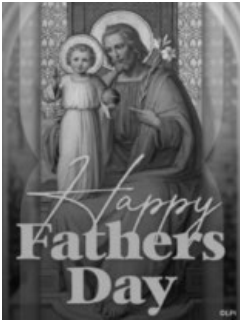

La Señal de la Cruz

Con frecuencia nos santiguamos con la señal de la cruz, pero a menudo olvidamos su significado y la increíble gracia que nos ofrece.

La oración invoca al Dios trinitario: Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo. Nos santiguamos con la cruz de Cristo e, invocando a la Trinidad, demostramos el deseo de consagrarnos y consagrar nuestro trabajo al Señor. Esta señal externa también les dice a los demás que pertenecemos a Dios y creemos en el poder de la cruz. Les dice que nos conmueve el don del amor de Cristo.

La señal de la cruz es, de hecho, una bendición. Recuerda nuestro bautismo, cuando fuimos santificados por primera vez y fuimos llamados para Cristo. También fue en nuestro bautismo que recibimos por primera vez el Espíritu de Adopción.

Al marcar nuestros cuerpos con la cruz, recordamos la pasión de Jesús y proclamamos el poder de su muerte. Es un reconocimiento de nuestra creencia en que Jesús es el Señor y que su cruz trae consigo la esperanza de la resurrección.

La señal de la cruz se hace con la mano derecha, recordando que Jesucristo está sentado como Rey a la diestra del Padre. Incluso podemos unir el pulgar y el índice durante la bendición para representar aún más la naturaleza trina del Dios que invocamos.

El uso de este gesto no se limita al principio y al final de las oraciones. Es una bendición que debe usarse con frecuencia al pedir a Dios protección, sabiduría, valentía, comprensión y paz. Incluso podemos usarla para reconocer la presencia de Dios con nosotros.

La señal de la cruz es un signo concreto del amor de Dios y de la acción continua de la Trinidad en nuestra vida diaria.

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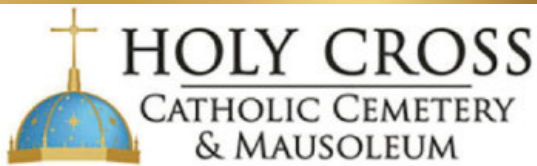

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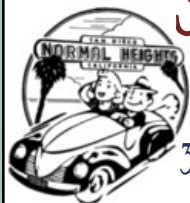
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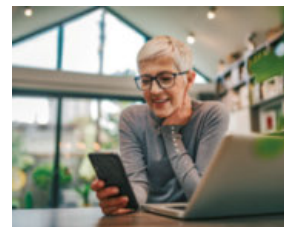
