The Mosaic of Christ's Church

When it comes to liturgical architecture and design, two churches in the United States are particularly impressive in their attention to detail and their exposition of the mosaic artform. The cathedral Basilica of St. Louis in St. Louis, Missouri, and the Basilica of the National Shrine in Washington, DC, are both decorated from floor to ceiling with tiny mosaic tiles. In fact, if one doesn't look closely enough, one might mistake the mosaics for paintings! The various shapes, sizes, and colors of the seemingly insignificant tiles come together to create one, large, unified portrait that communicates God's relationship with us.

Saint Peter and Saint Paul both had unique experiences of Christ, but both men shared a lot in common. Both were renamed by the Lord. Peter fell in his denial of Christ; Paul was thrown to the ground and blinded on his way to persecute the church. Both had conversion experiences that changed the trajectory of their lives. Both were deeply aware of their weaknesses but even more aware of Jesus' forgiveness and grace.

The preaching and the example of these holy men uniquely contributed to the life of the church and informed her understanding of the mercy and love of Christ. Can you imagine if one of them had decided to give up the life of the discipleship due to his weaknesses of his own sense of unworthiness? It is likely that their ability to respond to Jesus's question "*Who do you say that I am?*" played a major role in their commitment and dedication to the Christian life.

So who do I say that he is? What has he done in my life? What has he promised me? How has he healed me? Our view of the Lord will inform how we preach, listen, respond, pray, and live out our vocation. It is Christ who calls us, and it is the Spirit who urges us to share our encounter of Jesus with the world. We are not disqualified from the life of discipleship because of our past sins or our weaknesses. Our unique vocation is one essential tile in the great mosaic image of the church.

El Mosaico de la Iglesia de Cristo

En cuanto a arquitectura y diseño litúrgico, dos iglesias en Estados Unidos impresionan especialmente por su atención al detalle y la exposición del arte del mosaico. La Basílica Catedral de San Luis en San Luis, Misuri, y la Basílica del Santuario Nacional en Washington, D. C., están decoradas de arriba abajo con diminutos mosaicos. De hecho, si no se observa con atención, ¡podría confundirse con pinturas! Las diversas formas, tamaños y colores de estos mosaicos, aparentemente insignificantes, se unen para crear un gran retrato unificado que comunica la relación de Dios con nosotros.

San Pedro y San Pablo tuvieron experiencias únicas con Cristo, pero ambos compartieron mucho en común. Ambos recibieron un nombre nuevo por el Señor. Pedro cayó al negar a Cristo; Pablo fue arrojado al suelo y cegado mientras perseguía a la iglesia. Ambos tuvieron experiencias de conversión que cambiaron el curso de sus vidas. Ambos eran profundamente conscientes de sus debilidades, pero aún más conscientes del perdón y la gracia de Jesús.

La predicación y el ejemplo de estos santos hombres contribuyeron de forma única a la vida de la iglesia e informaron su comprensión de la misericordia y el amor de Cristo. ¿Se imaginan si uno de ellos hubiera decidido abandonar la vida de discipulado debido a sus debilidades o a su propia sensación de indignidad? Es probable que su capacidad para responder a la pregunta de Jesús: "¿Quién dicen que soy yo?", desempeñara un papel fundamental en su compromiso y dedicación a la vida cristiana.

Entonces, ¿quién digo que es Jesús? ¿Qué ha hecho en mi vida? ¿Qué me ha prometido? ¿Cómo me ha sanado? Nuestra visión del Señor determinará cómo predicamos, escuchamos, respondemos, oramos y vivimos nuestra vocación. Es Cristo quien nos llama, y es el Espíritu quien nos impulsa a compartir nuestro encuentro con Jesús con el mundo. Estamos invitados a la vida de discipulado, no importan nuestros pecados pasados ni nuestras debilidades. Nuestra vocación única es una pieza esencial en el gran mosaico de la iglesia.

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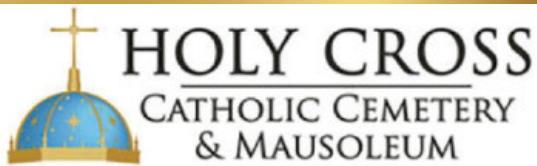

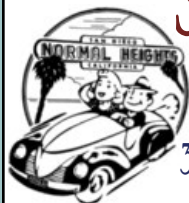
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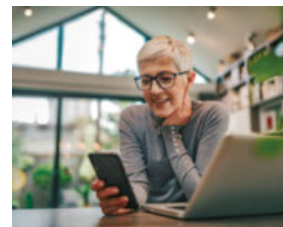
