The Role of a Disciple

The word disciple derives from the Latin *discere*, “to learn.” Disciples are those who commit to a life of learning from Christ, the teacher. They are open to growth in their faith and their love for the Lord.

In today’s gospel from Luke, we see the disciples learning directly from Christ. They experience their healing power stemming from the name of Jesus. Without him, without the Source, the disciples have no authority to preach, cast our demons, or cure the sick.

We also notice that Jesus sends these disciples in pairs. They are learning the value of their communion as they find support and the fellowship in one another.

The Christian life is a commitment to learn from the Master. When we are connected to the Source of Life, everything we encounter can provide an opportunity to grow in our relationship with God and with one another.

While Jesus teaches us directly at times, he also provides opportunities to learn from those who are saints and from those who are sinners. We might learn from our desires or from our failings. Every moment can be an opportunity to learn the ways of Jesus, because Christ transforms the entire human experience by his death and resurrection. God can chose to use anything or anyone for his good purpose. As disciples, we seek to be mindful enough to always ask: Where is God in this situation?

As we continue to learn the ways of Jesus, we remember that ministry to the people of God is not reserved for the clergy or those with a theology degree. There are various forms of healing and modes in which God seeks to walk with his people. While our hearts are still being formed in his love, he sends us forth to offer peace, healing, and reconciliation in the name of Jesus.

El Papel de un Discípulo

La palabra discípulo proviene del latín *discere*, "aprender". Los discípulos son aquellos que se comprometen a una vida de aprendizaje de Cristo, el maestro.

Están abiertos al crecimiento en su fe y su amor por el Señor. En el evangelio de hoy de Lucas, vemos a los discípulos aprendiendo directamente de Cristo. Experimentan su poder sanador que proviene del nombre de Jesús. Sin él, sin la Fuente, los discípulos no tienen autoridad para predicar, expulsar demonios o curar a los enfermos.

También notamos que Jesús envía a estos discípulos en parejas. Están aprendiendo el valor de su comunión mientras encuentran apoyo y compañerismo en los unos con los otros.

La vida cristiana es un compromiso de aprender del Maestro. Cuando estamos conectados a la Fuente de Vida, todo lo que encontramos puede brindar una oportunidad para crecer en nuestra relación con Dios y con los demás.

Mientras Jesús nos enseña directamente a veces, también nos brinda oportunidades para aprender de aquellos que son santos y de aquellos que son pecadores. Podemos aprender de nuestros deseos o de nuestras fallas. Cada momento puede ser una oportunidad para aprender los caminos de Jesús, porque Cristo transforma toda la experiencia humana por su muerte y resurrección. Dios puede elegir usar cualquier cosa o a cualquier persona para su buen propósito. Como discípulos, buscamos ser lo suficientemente conscientes como para siempre preguntar: ¿Dónde está Dios en esta situación?

Mientras continuamos aprendiendo los caminos de Jesús, recordamos que el ministerio a la gente de Dios no está reservado para el clero o aquellos con un título en teología. Hay varias formas de sanación y modos en que Dios busca caminar con su pueblo. Mientras nuestros corazones aún se están formando en su amor, nos envía para ofrecer paz, sanación y reconciliación en el nombre de Jesús.—*Liturgia Viva 2025*

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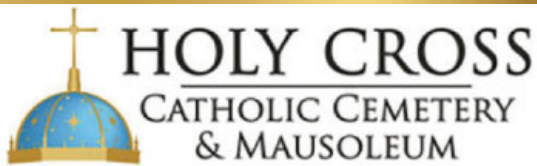

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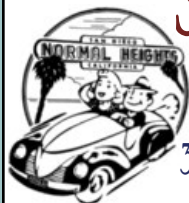
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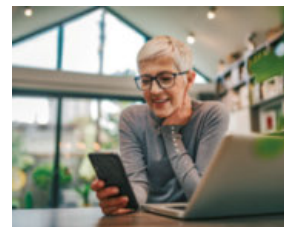
