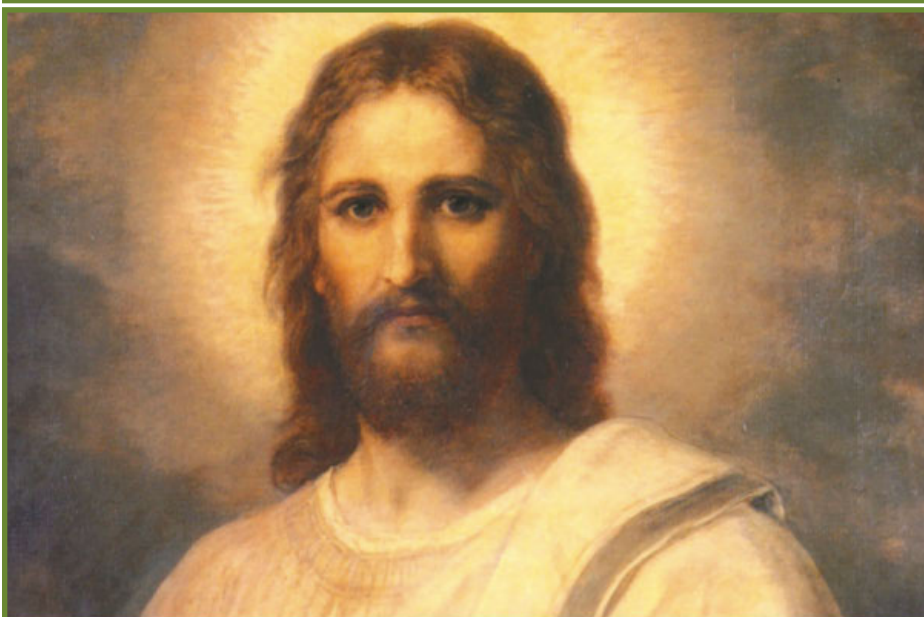

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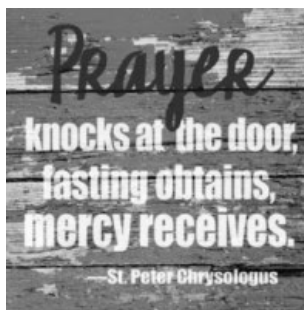

Persistent Prayer

In today's gospel the disciples ask Jesus to teach them how to pray. This is an interesting request, as the disciples have been following Jesus for some time now. They have surely seen Christ pray before. If we look throughout the gospel's, we see accounts of Jesus praying in any number of circumstances or situations. Jesus prays prayers of blessing and benediction. Jesus prays prayers of gratitude and thanksgiving. Jesus prays communally and privately. With this, the Lord's Prayer is situated within a much larger context of Jesus teaching his followers to pray in the everyday events of their lives.

The Lord's Prayer is a prayer *par excellence* in the sense that it not only affirms our ultimate dependence on God but also insists that we as the people of God must be invested in prayer. Jesus says "Forgive us our sins for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us" and continues with the story of the friend who asks for bread. Pope Francis attested, "Pray for the hungry. Then you feed them. That's how prayer works." Prayer is a way of living in relationship with God and others.

We must also remember that the answers to prayer do not look like what we might expect. When Jesus asks who would give a scorpion instead of an egg, or a snake instead of a fish, our immediate response is "No one would ever do that." But this is a human way of thinking. Perhaps the scorpion or snake are actually answered prayers, as God answers prayer according to God's will, not ours. May we be open to all possibilities of God's answered prayer.

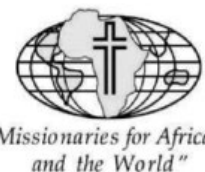

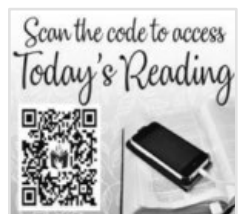

Oración Persistente

En el evangelio de hoy, los discípulos le piden a Jesús que les enseñe a orar. Esta es una solicitud interesante, ya que los discípulos han estado

siguiendo a Jesús durante algún tiempo. Seguramente han visto a Cristo orar antes. Si observamos a lo largo de los evangelios, vemos relatos de Jesús orando en diversas circunstancias o situaciones. Jesús ora oraciones de bendición y bendición. Jesús ora oraciones de gratitud y acción de gracias. Jesús ora de manera comunitaria y privada. Con esto, el Padre Nuestro se sitúa dentro de un contexto mucho más amplio de Jesús enseñando a sus seguidores a orar en los eventos cotidianos de sus vidas.

El Padre Nuestro es una oración por excelencia en el sentido de que no sólo afirma nuestra dependencia última de Dios, sino que también insiste en que nosotros, como pueblo de Dios, debemos estar invertidos en la oración. Jesús dice: "Perdónanos nuestros pecados, porque nosotros mismos perdonamos a todos los que nos deben" y continúa con la historia del amigo que pide pan. El Papa Francisco atestiguó: "Recen por los hambrientos. Luego les das de comer. Así es como funciona la oración". La oración es una forma de vivir en relación con Dios y con los demás.

También debemos recordar que las respuestas a la oración no se ven como podríamos esperar. Cuando Jesús pregunta quién daría un escorpión en lugar de un huevo, o una serpiente en lugar de un pez, nuestra respuesta inmediata es "Nadie haría eso nunca". Pero esta es una forma de pensar humana. Quizás el escorpión o la serpiente son en realidad oraciones respondidas, ya que Dios responde a la oración de acuerdo con la voluntad de Dios, no la nuestra. Que podamos estar abiertos a todas las posibilidades de las oraciones respondidas por Dios. —*Liturgia Viva*

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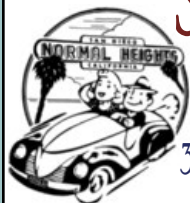
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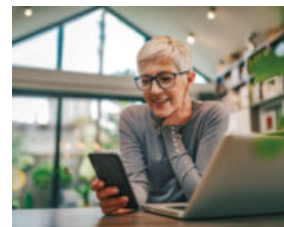
