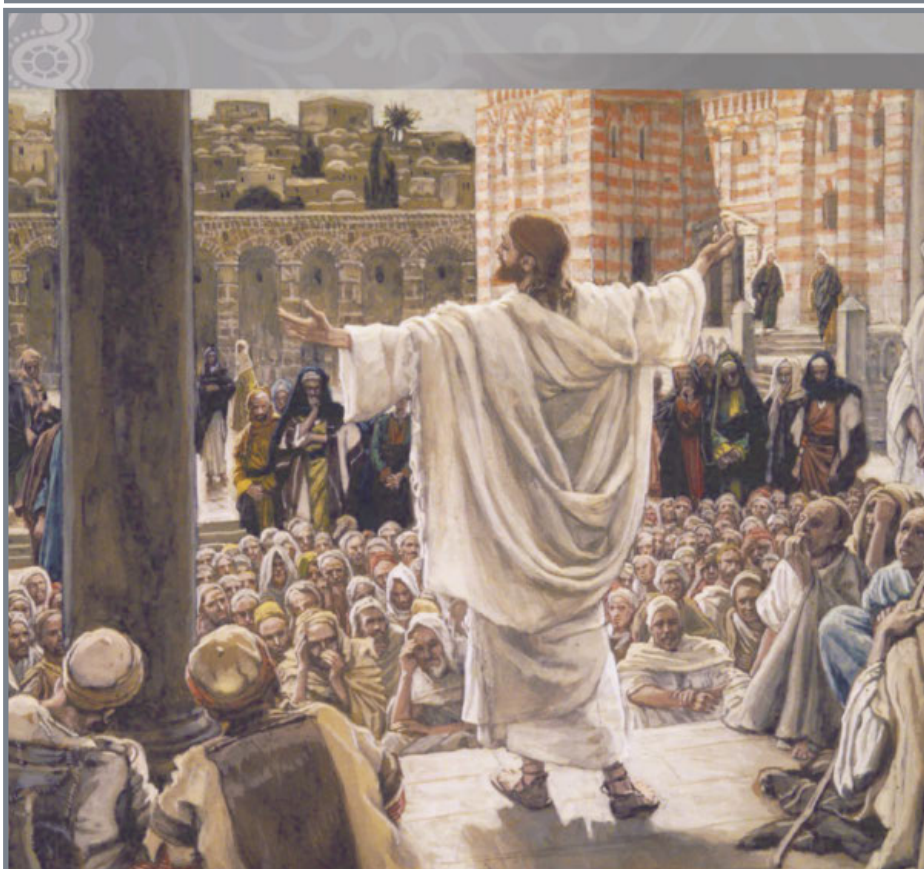

The Fire of Divine Love

One need not look far in order to find signs of division. Political rivalries, racial divides, injustices, and inequalities make headlines each day. Within our own communities we experience conflict, discord, and disagreement. The

church itself is not exempt. The early church, too, saw many signs of division, particularly as a result of its faith in Jesus Christ. The gospel shares this sad reality of what some early Christians were experiencing within the context of their very own families as they made the decision to follow the Lord.

Jesus comes to set the world ablaze with fire, but it is the fire of his divine love that will bring the division of which he speaks. Before the peace of the kingdom can be realized, a choice needs to be made. For those who chose to follow, there will be consequences, including division, persecution, or even death. The choice to live out the Christian faith come with risks. But the Letter to the Hebrews helps us call to mind that while we may experience division with our human family, the Mystical Body—the family of the church—is bound together and offers support for its members through intercessory prayer. We are surrounded by “so great a cloud of witnesses.”

We are not alone in our efforts to follow Jesus. In the midst of our broken world, Christ himself intercedes for us before the Father. In the Hail Mary, in the *Confiteor*, we reflect upon the division within our own hearts and “ask blessed Mary ever-Virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you my brothers and sisters, to pray for” us.

While in this life, we experience stark reminders of the division brought about by the rejection of God. We chose to conform our life to Christ are constantly being uplifted by the prayerful intercession and encouragement of a great cloud of witnesses and the entire Body of Christ.

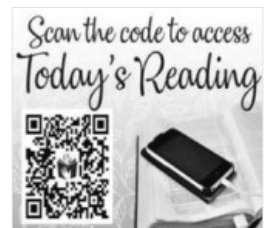

El Fuego del Amor Divino

No hay que buscar muy lejos para encontrar signos de división. Rivalidades políticas, divisiones raciales, injusticias y desigualdades acaparan titulares a diario. Dentro de nuestras propias comunidades, experimentamos conflicto, discordia y desacuerdo. La iglesia misma no está exenta. La iglesia primitiva también vio muchas señales de división, particularmente como resultado de su fe en Jesucristo. El evangelio comparte esta triste realidad de lo que algunos primeros cristianos experimentaban en el contexto de sus propias familias al tomar la decisión de seguir al Señor.

Jesús viene a encender el mundo con fuego, pero es el fuego de su amor divino el que traerá la división de la que habla. Antes de que la paz del reino pueda hacerse realidad, es necesario tomar una decisión. Para quienes decidan seguirlo, habrá consecuencias, como división, persecución o incluso la muerte. La decisión de vivir la fe cristiana conlleva riesgos. Pero la Carta a los Hebreos nos ayuda a recordar que, si bien podemos experimentar división con nuestra familia humana, el Cuerpo Místico —la familia de la Iglesia— está unido y ofrece apoyo a sus miembros mediante la oración intercesora. Estamos rodeados de una gran nube de testigos.

No estamos solos en nuestros esfuerzos por seguir a Jesús. En medio de nuestro mundo quebrantado, Cristo mismo intercede por nosotros ante el Padre. En el Ave María y en el *Confiteor*, reflexionamos sobre la división en nuestros corazones y pedimos a la bienaventurada María siempre Virgen, a todos los ángeles y santos, y a ustedes, mis hermanos y hermanas, que intercedan por nosotros.

En esta vida, experimentamos duros recordatorios de la división provocada por el rechazo de Dios. Decidimos conformar nuestra vida a la de Cristo y somos constantemente inspirados por la intercesión y el aliento de una gran nube de testigos y de todo el Cuerpo de Cristo. —*Liturgia Viva*

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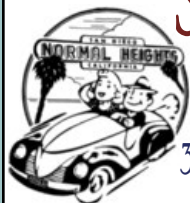
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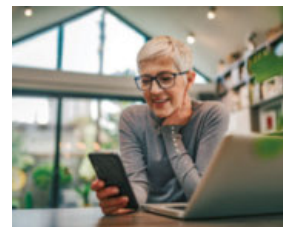
