Cross of our Hope, Tree of Our Salvation

On September 14, 320, St. Helena—mother of Emperor Constantine the Great—is said to have discovered the true cross, that is, the wood that belonged to the original cross of Christ at his Crucifixion. Both history and legend have blended in the story of the discovery that survives today.

Helena made it her goal to discover the place of the crucifixion of Jesus. A divine sign enabled her to locate the site in Jerusalem, which she later had excavated. The project was somewhat complicated by the fact that a sanctuary of Venus was built on the spot. However once the buildings were demolished, the ground underneath exposed three crosses, along with the title and nails that were used at the Lord's crucifixion.

To determine which was the true cross of Christ, Helena took the three fragments to an ill person, but only one of the fragments brought about his recovery. Recognizing that she has with certainty uncovered the site of the Lord's death, Helena built a church where the true cross had been discovered. The church was dedicated on September 14, 334. From this point onward, both the anniversary of the finding of the cross and dedication of the basilica were celebrated. The Jerusalem church is now known as the Church of the Holy Sepulcher, or the Church of the Resurrection.

This holy feast recalls the extraordinary power and grace of the cross of Christ. The religious order known as the Congregation of the Holy Cross puts it in this way, in its Constitution 8, on "The Cross: Our Hope": *"There is no failure the Lord's love cannot reverse, no humiliation he cannot exchange for blessing, no anger he cannot dissolve, no routine he cannot transfigure. All is swallowed up in victory. He has nothing but gifts to offer. It remains only for us to find how even the cross can be borne as a gift."*

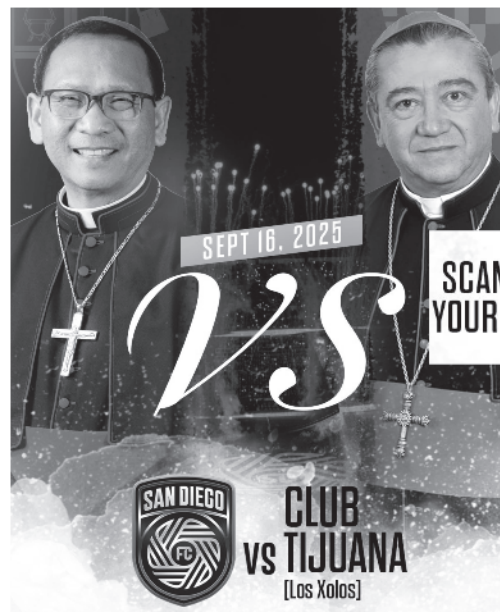

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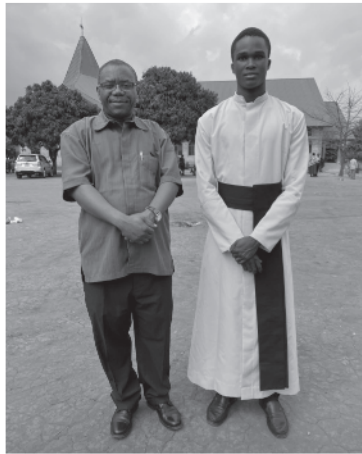

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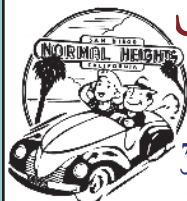
