May They Rest in Peace

This month, the church is invited to remember the faithful departed, who are commemorated in a special way on this day.

In some places of worship, an altar or remembrance will be set up for the faithful to place pictures of or articles belonging to the deceased loved ones. A book of remembrance might also be made available so the faithful can list the names of their deceased for the benefit of the church's intercession. We might even make a pilgrimage to our local cemetery or the grave of a loved one, offer flowers, and pray for their souls.

Throughout the world on this commemoration, the church is praying for the dead. We lovingly entrust their souls to God and pray for their redemption. For the souls in purgatory who still await God's salvation, we recall their promise of eternal life and ask the Father to bring them into his loving embrace.

We also pray for ourselves. Our reflection on our mortality is a reminder for us who remain to live with our death always before our eyes. Saint Ambrose, in a book on his brother, Satyrus, wrote, *"Let us then be exiles from our body, so as not to be exiles from Christ."*

All of the options for the Readings today reflect the array of options available for the Mass of Christian Burial. It may be the case that the readings selected today will recall for some the funeral liturgy of their own deceased loved ones.

In the recalling of our memories, we recall our reason for hope. Along with our beloved dead, we entrust ourselves to the loving care of God and call upon all of the angels and saints to intercede on our behalf for the Lord's mercy and forgiveness.

Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord. And let perpetual light shine upon them. May the souls of the faithful departed through the mercy of God rest in peace. Amen.
