Rejoice and be Glad, for Your Reward will be Great in Heaven

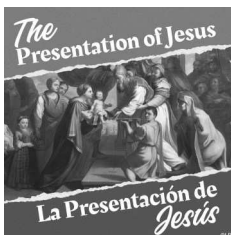
“Rejoice and be glad, for your reward will be great in heaven.” Here, in a nutshell, is the Christian belief about the afterlife. We trust that heaven is open to believers who accept the

gift of salvation and follow the way of the Lord, even (or especially) when that way is difficult!

The beatitudes in today’s Gospel give us a program for following the path to heaven. These famous words offer a kind of twofold image. There are, on the one hand, the beatitudes about what we should do and be: poor in spirit, meek, merciful, clean of heart, and peacemakers. Such qualities are reflections of the nature of God in whose image we are meant to live. When we embrace and reflect this image to the world, there is no doubt we are walking on the path of God’s will.

Then, there are also the beatitudes about what we are called to endure: mourning, hunger for righteousness, persecutions and insults due to our belief in Jesus. These are the trials that often beset the life of a faithful Christian—admittedly more so in some ages and areas than in others. But Jesus makes it clear that even these trials and struggles are a sign that a Christian is on the right path, not that God has abandoned him or her, but that the reward of heaven lies around the corner.

One of the greatest consolations of our faith is that even when life does not unfold according to our own perfect designs, even when there is suffering to deal with, even when we do not have great success in the eyes of the world, we can maintain hope and peace as we await the “reward” of the just. The eternal happiness of heaven will be worth every ounce of temporary trial here on earth. —*Cycles of Faith*

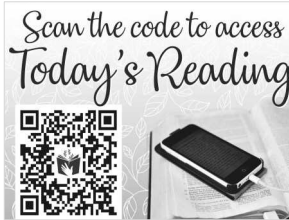

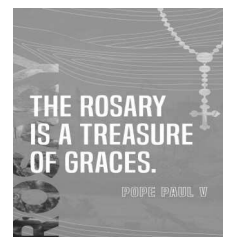

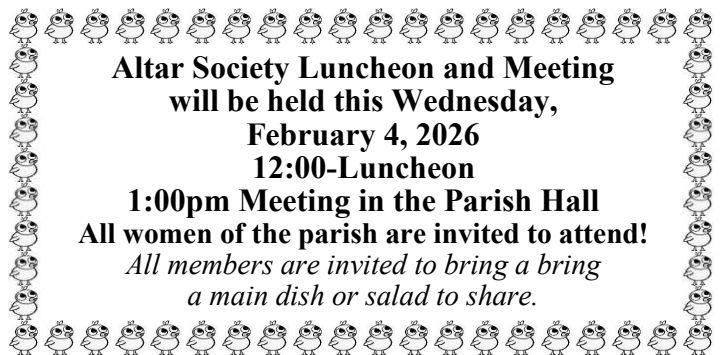

Alégrense y Regocijense, porque Su Recompensa será Grande en el Cielo

“Alégrense y regocijense, porque su recompensa será grande en el cielo.” Aquí, en pocas palabras,

está la creencia cristiana sobre la vida después de la muerte. Confiamos en que el cielo está abierto a los creyentes que aceptan el don de la salvación y siguen el camino del Señor, ¡incluso (o especialmente) cuando ese camino es difícil!

Las bienaventuranzas del Evangelio de hoy nos ofrecen un programa para seguir el camino hacia el cielo. Estas palabras famosas presentan una especie de imagen doble. Por un lado, están las bienaventuranzas sobre lo que debemos hacer y ser: pobres en espíritu, mansos, misericordiosos, limpios de corazón y pacificadores. Tales cualidades son reflejos de la naturaleza de Dios, en cuya imagen estamos destinados a vivir. Cuando abrazamos y reflejamos esta imagen al mundo, no hay duda de que estamos caminando por el camino de la voluntad de Dios.

Luego, también están las bienaventuranzas sobre lo que estamos llamados a soportar: el llanto, el hambre de justicia, las persecuciones y los insultos debido a nuestra fe en Jesús. Estas son las pruebas que a menudo afectan la vida de un cristiano fiel—admitiendo que algunas épocas y lugares son más difíciles que otros. Pero Jesús deja claro que incluso estas pruebas y luchas son una señal de que un cristiano está en el camino correcto, no de que Dios lo haya abandonado, sino de que la recompensa del cielo está a la vuelta de la esquina.

Una de las mayores consolaciones de nuestra fe es que, incluso cuando la vida no se desarrolla según nuestros propios planes perfectos, incluso cuando hay sufrimiento que afrontar, incluso cuando no tenemos gran éxito a los ojos del mundo, podemos mantener la esperanza y la paz mientras esperamos la “recompensa” de los justos. La felicidad eterna del cielo valdrá cada onza de prueba temporal aquí en la tierra. — *Ciclos de Fe*

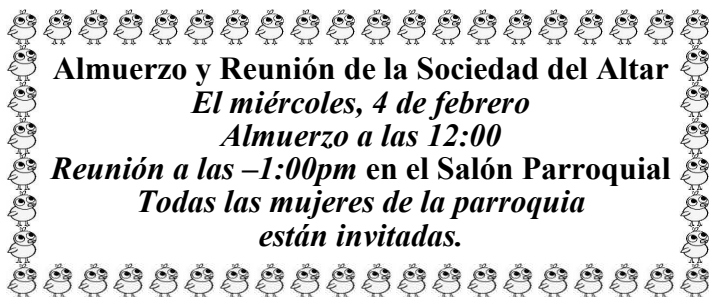

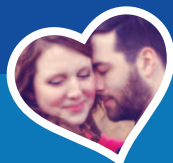
