The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity consists of eight days beginning January 18 (at that time the feast of the Chair of Peter), and ending on January 25, the feast of the Conversion of

St. Paul. The Franciscan Friars of the Atonement, founded in the early twentieth century in Graymoor, NY, sought to promote unity among Anglicans and Roman Catholics. Paul James Wattson, a former Episcopalian priest, founded the community, which was formally accepted into the Catholic communion.

The idea for Christian unity soon began to catch on, and by the 1930s, more and more Christians welcomed such a focus. Suggestions for prayer and education are distributed each year, emphasizing a jointly chosen theme. The 1964 Vatican II document on ecumenism, *Unitatis Redintegratio*, gave a great boost to the octave, so that today many Christians worldwide promote and participate in the octave time of prayer.

The emphasis on both Peter and Paul aptly fits into the rationale of the octave. Peter is seen as the source of unity within the Christian tradition. Paul is highlighted due to his vision of bringing all to Christ. The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is an ideal opportunity to pray for and promote respect, understanding, and, hopefully, eventual unity among Christians. To learn more, *visit geii.org*.

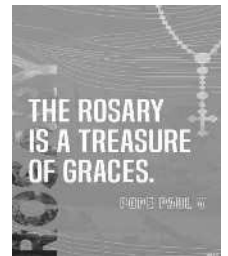
Multilingual Novena for Life, *January 16-24*

Ordinary time is the longest season of the liturgical year. It begins the Monday after January 6, the Epiphany, and goes until the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday, the beginning of Lent. That period can last anywhere from five to eight weeks, depending on when Easter is celebrated. Ordinary time picks up again the Monday after Pentecost Sunday and lasts from twenty-three to twenty-seven weeks, until the end of the liturgical year, the Saturday before Advent begins.

Why the name ordinary? “Ordinary” is not in contrast to “extraordinary” or “special” but rather stresses the Latin language notion of “ordinal” or numbered Sundays. The Latin title for the season, *tempus ordinarium*, conveys the sense that this time of the year is measured or numbered time. Measured time can allude simply to the numbered Sundays, or the notion that these Sundays are a “measured” time to deepen and immerse ourselves completely in the realities of Jesus’ incarnation, ministry, passion, death, and resurrection. Ordinary time offers us the opportunity to connect the ordinary lived experiences of our lives with those of Jesus, who modeled for us how to live a truly human existence.

Los Frailes Franciscanos de la Expiación, fundados a principios del siglo XX en Graymoor, Nueva York, buscaron promover la unidad entre anglicanos y católicos romanos. Paul James Wattson, un antiguo sacerdote episcopaliano, fundó la comunidad, que fue aceptada formalmente en la comunión católica.

La idea de la unidad cristiana pronto comenzó a extenderse, y en la década de los años 30, cada vez más cristianos acogieron con agrado esta iniciativa. Cada año se distribuyen sugerencias para la oración y la reflexión, haciendo hincapié en un tema elegido conjuntamente. El documento del Concilio Vaticano II sobre el ecumenismo, Unitatis Redintegratio, de 1964, dio un gran impulso a la octava, de modo que hoy en día muchos cristianos en todo el mundo promueven y participan en este tiempo de oración.

El énfasis en Pedro y Pablo encaja perfectamente con el sentido de la octava. Pedro es considerado la fuente de unidad dentro de la tradición cristiana. Pablo es destacado por su visión de llevar a todos a Cristo. La Semana de Oración por la Unidad de los Cristianos es una oportunidad ideal para orar y promover el respeto, la comprensión y con la esperanza, la unidad final entre los cristianos. 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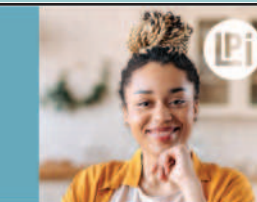

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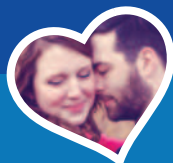
