**Rite of Election and Continuing Conversion 2026**

The Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion will take place this Sunday afternoon, **March 1, 2026** at the University of San Diego. This year our parish will have eight Catechumens and four adults candidates.

At the *Rite of Election* the catechumens and candidates in our parish along with those throughout the Diocese of San Diego will affirm their intention to join the Church. The Church makes its "election" of the catechumens to receive the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Eucharist, Confirmation) at the Easter Vigil. The catechumens write their names in the Book of the Elect as a pledge of fidelity. After the rite they will be called "the elect" and begin a Period of Purification and Enlightenment for the remainder of Lent. Keep them in your prayers as they continue their preparation to receive the sacraments at the Easter Vigil.

**Diocese of San Diego**

As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for the Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in forma specifica by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.

*After leaving St. Didacus, Sr. Bernadine served as the founding Principal of Good Shepherd School in Mira Mesa. She then returned to Ireland, where she taught English and administered to Secondary school students and their families for thirty years.*



**DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO**

Tal como fue anunciado previamente por la Diócesis en 2022, al concluir una visita canónica de tres años, la Sede Apostólica (*especialmente la entonces Congregación para los Institutos de Vida Consagrada y las Sociedades de Vida Apostólica*), mediante un Decreto fechado el 13 de mayo de 2022 y aprobado en *forma específica* por el Papa Francisco, suprimió el instituto religioso anteriormente conocido como las Trinitarias de María. Con esta supresión, las antiguas miembros de las Trinitarias quedaron automáticamente dispensadas de sus votos y ya no están autorizadas a presentarse como religiosas. No existe derecho de apelación, y las Trinitarias han dejado de existir como instituto religioso reconocido por la Iglesia Católica.
