You are the Light of the World

Today's gospel is a continuation of the Sermon on the Mount, reminding us that we glorify God by our lives. Just as salt preserves and flavors food, Jesus tells his disciples that they are to offer themselves to the world. Just as lamps provide a path, Jesus tells his disciples they are to guide others. Following the law outlined in the Beatitudes, these everyday images illustrate the role and duty of the Christian.

How are Christians to let their lives be flavorful and guiding? Isaiah offers some guidelines: "Share your bread with the hungry, shelter the oppressed and homeless, clothe the naked when you see them, and do not turn your back on your own." These are not some nice acts of piety or kindness but integral elements of following Jesus. Discipleship is utterly rational.

But notice that Jesus does not call his disciples to be "like" salt and light. Rather Jesus calls his disciples to *be* salt and light. Salt and light do not exist for themselves—salt gives taste and light gives radiance. As Christians, we do not exist for ourselves. Rather, everything we do gives glory to God. We pray that we can resist the temptation to make the good about us. In the words of Paul, all we do is for the sake of the gospel. —*Living Liturgy*

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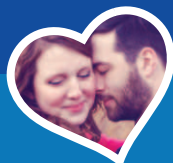
