

Let Us Place Ourselves Before Christ

Saint Andrew of Crete, an eighth-century bishop and theologian, in reflecting upon Christ's triumphant entry into Jerusalem, once wrote, "It is ourselves that we must spread under Christ's

feet, not coats or lifeless branches or shoots of trees, matter which wastes away and delights the eye for only a few brief hours. But we have clothed ourselves with Christ's grace, with the whole Christ – for as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ – so let us spread ourselves like coats under his feet."

As we enter into this Holy Week, we need to take Andrew of Crete's advice and spread ourselves out before Christ; we need to join with other disciples and be there with Jesus on the path to Jerusalem, to gather in the Upper Room, and to learn the lessons of humility as our feet are washed and we learn to wash the feet of others. We need to sing in the garden after the Last Supper and be there with Peter as he denies the Messiah. We need to stand at the foot of the cross with Mary and John.

We need this week, which calls us to set aside our routines, to remove ourselves from all that is predictable in our lives and simply spread ourselves out before the Lord. We need to watch and wait together as we once again recall the events which gained for us the great and precious gift of our salvation. —*Faith Content*

Diocese of San Diego

As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for the Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in forma specifica by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.


April is National Child Abuse Prevention Month

Pongámonos ante Cristo







DIÓCESIS DE SAN DIEGO

Tal como fue anunciado previamente por la Diócesis en 2022, al concluir una visita canónica de tres años, la Sede Apostólica (*especialmente la entonces Congregación para los Institutos de Vida Consagrada y las Sociedades de Vida Apostólica*), mediante un Decreto fechado el 13 de mayo de 2022 y aprobado en *forma específica* por el Papa Francisco, suprimió el instituto religioso anteriormente conocido como las Trinitarias de María. Con esta supresión, las antiguas miembros de las Trinitarias quedaron automáticamente dispensadas de sus votos y ya no están autorizadas a presentarse como religiosas. No existe derecho de apelación, y las Trinitarias han dejado de existir como instituto religioso reconocido por la Iglesia Católica.
