Joy

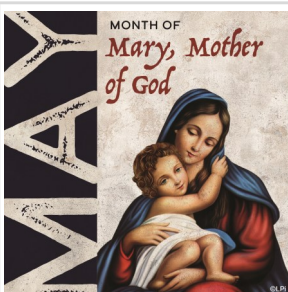
In today's first reading, we hear about the visit of Philip to the city of Samaria after the resurrection of Jesus. Philip "proclaimed the Christ" to the people of that city, and when they heard his message, "[t]here was great joy in that city." Another translation of that verse puts it even more strikingly: "The rejoicing in that town rose to a fever pitch." Since today's responsorial psalm also emphasizes the theme of joy, the lectionary reminds us today of the important place of joy in Christian faith, life, and spirituality.

In the gospels, the joyful tone is set immediately following the annunciation of the angel to Mary that she will be the mother of the Son of God, when Mary goes to visit her cousin Elizabeth. As soon as she enters Elizabeth's presence, the unborn John the Baptist leaps for joy in his mother's womb. And then Mary breaks out into praise, proclaiming a hymn of joy in God's salvation: "My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord;/my spirit rejoices in God my savior."

So many great figures in Christian history are remembered for the joy with which they experienced God and/or shared the good news of Jesus with those around them. Among many we could mention, Saint Philip Neri stands out. This sixteenth-century saint of the city of Rome is known as the "apostle of joy." The seventeenth-century philosopher Blaise Pascal also comes to mind. His "Memorial" is a page of notes that he scribbled in the midst of a dramatic experience of God and then kept sewn inside the lining of his coat for the rest of his life. Among the notes, he recorded his reaction to his experience; "Joy, joy, joy, tears of joy."

These final weeks of Easter are a good time for us to open ourselves anew to the joy that faith in the risen Jesus offers us. One way to do that might be to read the important but too forgotten apostolic exhortation of Pope Paul the VI, *Guadette in Domino*, On Christian Joy—published in fact, exactly fifty-one years ago today.

Diocese of San Diego

As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for the Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in forma specifica by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.

Alegría

En la primera lectura de hoy, escuchamos acerca de la visita de Felipe a la ciudad de Samaria después de la resurrección de Jesús. Felipe “proclamó al Cristo” al pueblo de esa ciudad, y cuando escucharon su mensaje, “*hubo una gran alegría en aquella ciudad.*” Otra traducción de ese versículo lo expresa aún más sorprendentemente: “*El júbilo en esa ciudad alcanzó un punto álgido.*” Dado que el salmo responsorial de hoy también enfatiza el tema de la alegría, el leccionario nos recuerda hoy la importancia de la alegría en la fe, la vida y la espiritualidad cristianas.

En los evangelios, el tono de alegría se establece inmediatamente después de la anunciación del ángel a María de que ella será la madre del Hijo de Dios, cuando María va a visitar a su prima Isabel. Tan pronto como entra en la presencia de Isabel, Juan el Bautista no nacido salta de alegría en el vientre de su madre. Y entonces María estalla en alabanzas, proclamando un himno de alegría por la salvación de Dios: “Mi alma proclama la grandeza del Señor; mi espíritu se alegra en Dios mi Salvador.”

Muchas figuras importantes de la historia cristiana son recordadas por la alegría con la que experimentaron a Dios y/o compartieron la buena noticia de Jesús con quienes los rodeaban. Entre muchos que podríamos mencionar, destaca San Felipe Neri. Este santo del siglo XVI de la ciudad de Roma es conocido como el “apóstol de la alegría.” También viene a la mente el filósofo del siglo XVII Blaise Pascal. Su “Memorial” es una página de notas que escribió en medio de una experiencia dramática de Dios y que luego mantuvo cosida dentro del forro de su abrigo durante el resto de su vida. Entre las notas, registró su reacción a su experiencia: “Alegría, alegría, alegría, lágrimas de alegría.”

Estas últimas semanas de Pascua son un buen momento para abrirnos de nuevo a la alegría que la fe en el Jesús resucitado nos ofrece. Una forma de hacerlo podría ser leer la exhortación apostólica importante pero demasiado olvidada del Papa Pablo VI, *Gaudete in Domino*, Sobre la Alegría Cristiana, publicada, de hecho, exactamente hace cincuenta y un años hoy.

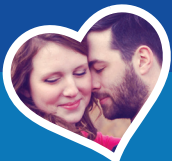
