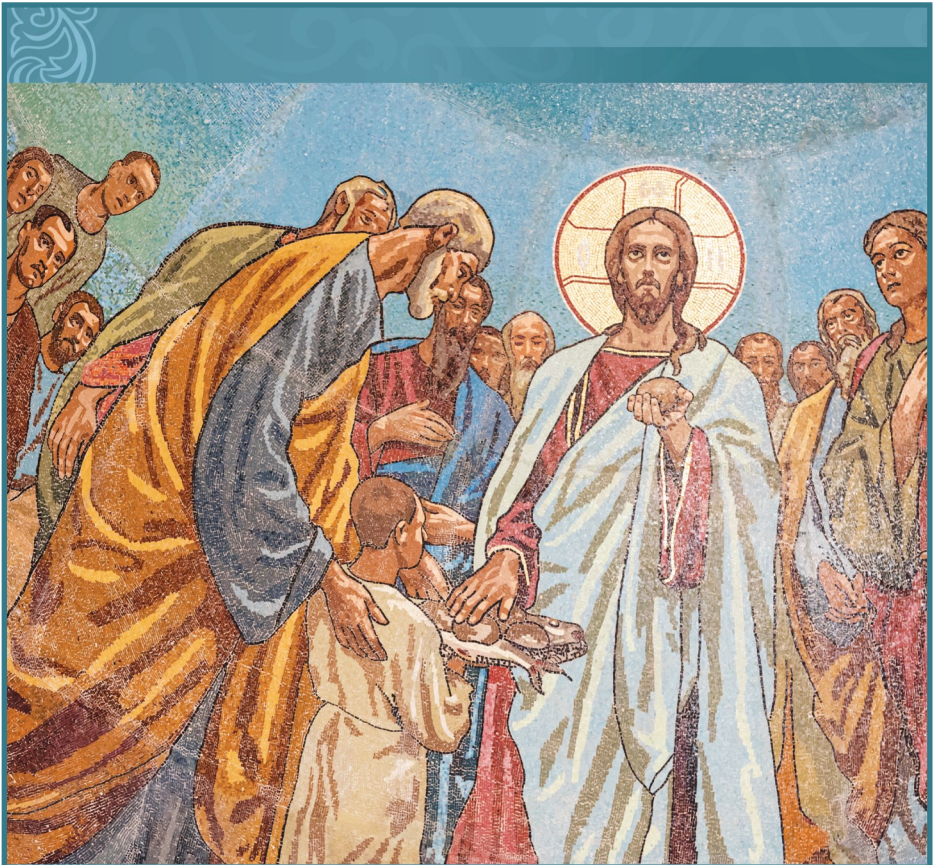

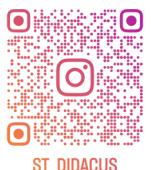

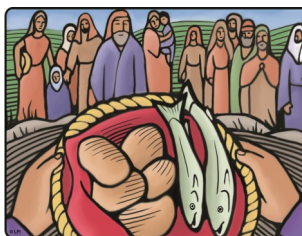

"They all ate and were satisfied."

The multiplication of loaves and fishes is one of the greatest miracles of Jesus, shared in some form or the other in all the gospels, and it is the most richly symbolic. The book of Isaiah proclaims in the first reading that all can come to God and be fed, "without paying and without cost." Jesus here begins to fulfill this passage and offers a sign that points to a greater reality. While Jesus's ability to feed the crowd is incredible, it is not the end itself. Jesus clearly did not end world hunger (that task is on our to-do list) but he did come to offer us food nonetheless—by his own body and blood in the Eucharist. In this miracle, Jesus took, broke, and gave the bread that feeds our souls. The multiplication of loaves and fishes is a sign of the great abundance that God wishes to offer us—nourishment such that we will never hunger for anything else. —*Living Liturgy*

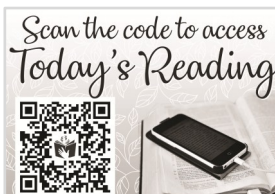

Diocese of San Diego-Trinitarian Suppression

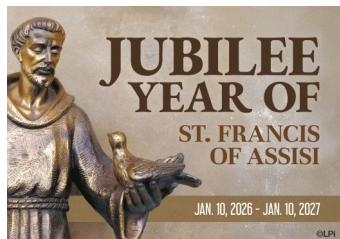
As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for the Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in forma specific by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.

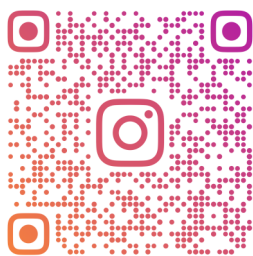

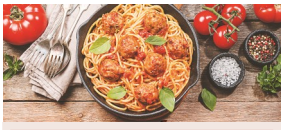

La multiplicación de los panes y los peces es uno de los mayores milagros de Jesús, narrado de una forma u otra en todos los Evangelios, y es también uno de los más ricos en simbolismo. El libro de Isaías proclama en la primera lectura que todos pueden acudir a Dios y ser alimentados, “sin pagar y sin costo alguno”. En este pasaje, Jesús comienza a cumplir esa promesa y ofrece una señal que apunta hacia una realidad aún más grande.

Aunque la capacidad de Jesús para alimentar a la multitud es increíble, no es un fin en sí mismo. Claramente, Jesús no puso fin al hambre en el mundo (esa tarea sigue siendo parte de nuestra responsabilidad), pero sí vino a ofrecernos alimento: su propio Cuerpo y Sangre en la Eucaristía. En este milagro, Jesús tomó el pan, lo partió y lo dio, prefigurando el Pan que alimenta nuestras almas.

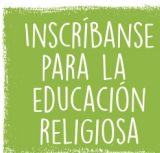

Diócesis de San Diego

Algunos nombres de sacerdotes fraudulentos son: Obispo Lauro, Octavio Aguilar Oliveros, Gabriel Figueroa y Raymundo Figueroa Pérez. Si alguna persona ha sido víctima de fraude en relación con estos sacerdotes, por favor, contacte a las autoridades.

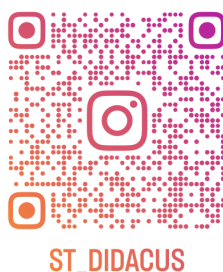

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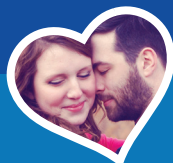
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
