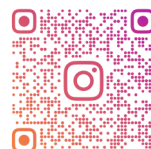

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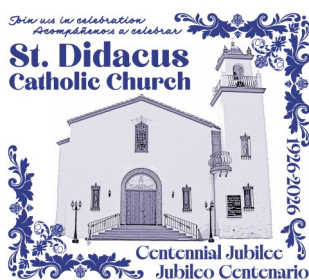

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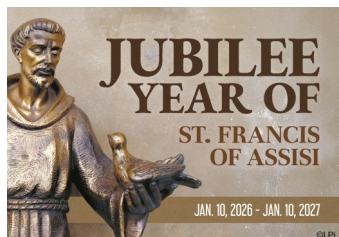
Centenary Jubilee News

“Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid.”

In this Sunday’s gospel, the disciples are vividly aware that they are not in control of their circumstances. As they journey on the “Barque of Peter” toward Jesus, who has gone before them to pray, it is the darkest part of the night and the wind is tossing the boat. They are seemingly alone. As Jesus appears to them on the water, they do not recognize Jesus and instead react precisely opposite to Jesus’s intention for them—they fear what they believe is a ghost. When Jesus appears to us in the church, especially in ways that we do not expect, do we recognize him? Allow him to help us? Or do we think that we have to do it all ourselves—*our church, our way*? At least in this darkest moment, Jesus reassures the disciples in the boat that he is present with them, proving dominion over even the weather. Where Jesus is, there is no need to fear.

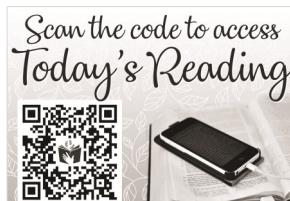

Diocese of San Diego-Trinitarian Suppression

As previously announced by the Diocese in 2022, at the conclusion of a three-year visitation, the Apostolic See (*specifically the then-Congregation for the Institutes of Consecrated Life and Societies of Apostolic Life*) by means of a Decree dated 13 May 2022 and approved in forma specific by Pope Francis, suppressed the religious institute formerly known as the Trinitarians of Mary. With this suppression, the former members of the Trinitarians were automatically dispensed from their vows and are no longer permitted to present themselves as religious. There is no right of appeal, and the Trinitarians have ceased to exist as a religious institute recognized by the Catholic Church.

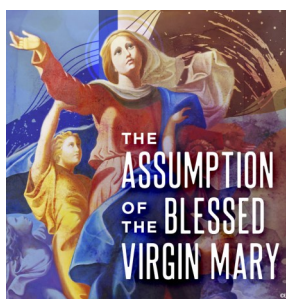
Knitting Group News

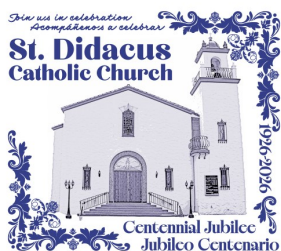


The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary
Saturday, August 15, 2026
Bilingual Mass at 8am

In the gospel reading, we hear Mary proclaim what we now recognize as the *Magnificat*, a prayer of praise titled from

the first line—*Magnificat anima mea Dominum*, Latin for “My soul magnifies the Lord.” In this moment Mary rejoices with Elizabeth and remembers all that God has done for her and for Israel throughout many generations. But what is most significant about this hymn of praise is that it is not just words. Mary is offering praise from her entire being. Her words express what her actions demonstrate—the entirety of her life is a profession of praise for who God is and what God has done for God's beloved.

On August 15, 2026 we celebrate Mary's glorious assumption, in which she is taken body and soul into heaven. Having been conceived without original sin and she lived in the full grace of God without personal sin, Mary was not subject to personal decay that comes with death. Instead, Mary experienced what the rest of us hope for and are promised: the resurrection of our earthly bodies when Christ returns. Mary was chosen and set apart by God from the moment of her immaculate conception, preparing her to fulfill the call that she received. And as she chose daily to live by her words of her *Magnificat*, conforming her life to the will of a generous, mighty, and loving God. Elizabeth recognized the work of God in Mary's life as well, proclaiming, “Blessed are you among women and blessed is the fruit of your womb.” The presence of the Holy Spirit within Mary was so radiant that others could not help but see God's glorious grace at work within her.

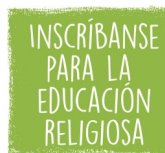


«¡Ánimo, soy yo; no tengan miedo!»

En el Evangelio de hoy, los discípulos son conscientes de que no tienen el control de las circunstancias que los rodean. Mientras navegan en la “Barca de Pedro” hacia Jesús, quien se ha adelantado para orar, se encuentran en la parte más oscura de la noche y el viento sacude la embarcación. Aparentemente están solos. Cuando Jesús se les aparece caminando sobre el agua, no lo reconocen y reaccionan de manera totalmente opuesta a lo que Él desea para ellos: sienten miedo, pensando que se trata de un fantasma.

Cuando Jesús se manifiesta en nuestra Iglesia, especialmente de maneras que no esperamos, ¿lo reconocemos? ¿Le permitimos ayudarnos? ¿O pensamos que debemos hacerlo todo por nuestra cuenta: *nuestra* Iglesia, a *nuestra* manera? 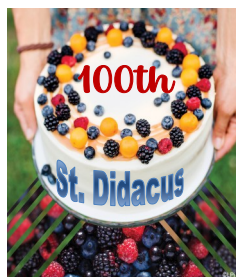

Algunos nombres de sacerdotes fraudulentos son: Obispo Lauro, Octavio Aguilar Oliveros, Gabriel Figueroa y Raymundo Figueroa Pérez. Si alguna persona ha sido víctima de fraude en relación con estos sacerdotes, por favor, contacte a las autoridades.

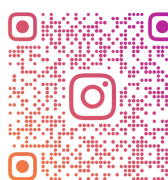

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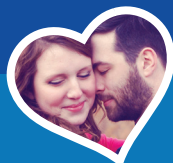
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
